#### Lockers Cleaned and Instruments Returned by May 30th

Students should begin to clean out lockers immediately so that directors can inventory school instruments and equipment starting next week.

Students may keep marching instruments, grad band instruments, and/or folios in their assigned lockers through June 4<sup>th</sup> for the Newburg Parade but should **take everything else home**. Please remove your personally-owned reeds, oils, swabs, pencils, and grease from all instrument cases. Following that, lockers will be emptied out into the lost and found by equipment managers.

We ask that **ALL school-owned instruments are returned** and **remain at school by May 30<sup>th</sup>** following the Memorial Day Parade. You may use them through the end of the year but instruments will be inventoried starting next week.
